

## **Course Outline – Youth Intermediate**

This course is for **learners from 8 years of age** who have either successfully completed our *Youth Beginners 1* course or can demonstrate a basic knowledge of age-appropriate German vocabulary and grammar.

This is an engaging course with a communicative approach to extended grammar and vocabulary acquisition and provides lots of opportunities to practise effectively speaking, understanding, reading and writing German. It caters for different abilities and learning styles and it encourages students to make cross-cultural references.

German grammar and new vocabulary are covered at the end of each chapter in the *Magnet A1*neu textbook, which is aligned with the language proficiencies outlined in the *Common European*Framework of Reference for Languages.

On successful completion of this course students will move up to the Youth Advanced course.

- Talking about fast food restaurants

- Talking about sport and fitness studios
- Discussing interests and preferences
- Describing items of clothing and discussing fashion
- Talking about the price of clothing items and buying clothes
