



## Course Outline - Adult Advanced

**Course aim:** This course builds on students' prior intermediate competency and skills, increase your communicative fluency and grammatical repertoire, and letting you gain a better understanding of cultural differences.

**Prior knowledge:** This course requires a solid understanding of the fundamentals of the German language and preferably familiarity with the content of an intermediate-level German course.
