

## **Course Outline - Youth Advanced**

This course is for **learners from 10 years of age** who successfully completed the Youth Beginners 2 or Youth Intermediate course or can demonstrate a sound knowledge of the German language.

This is an engaging course with a communicative approach to extended grammar and vocabulary acquisition. It also provides lots of opportunities to increase student's communicative fluency as well as their German reading and writing skills. It caters for different abilities and learning styles and it encourages students to make cross-cultural references, thereby gaining a better understanding of cultural differences.

German grammar and new vocabulary are covered at the end of each chapter in the *Magnet A2*neu textbook, which is aligned with the language proficiencies outlined in the *Common European*Framework of Reference for Languages.

On successful completion of this course students will move up to the *Youth Advanced continued / DSD 1 Preparation* course, which will give them the unique opportunity to obtain the *Deutsches Sprachdiplom 1* certificate.
