

Course Outline – Youth Advanced Continued

This course is designed for students who have successfully completed our *Youth Advanced* course and new high school students of high A2 or B1 level. The course requires a solid understanding of the fundamentals of the German language.

The aim of this course is to rapidly advance students' linguistic skills, knowledge of grammar and expand vocabulary.

The textbook *Magnet B1* is aligned with the language proficiencies outlined in the *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages*.
