



Course Outline – Kids Beginners Level A1

This course is for children **from 7 years of age or school grade 2 & 3.**

Children will be introduced to the German language through the textbook *Der grüne Max Neu 1*, which emphasizes age-appropriate and authentic language. The study material is presented in a playful and enjoyable manner and will make children aware of language learning techniques and transfer skills. Grammar, Reading and Writing will be taught more in depth.

Children moving up from the Young Learners course will build on the knowledge attained at that level while new students will soon compete with them with their acquired speaking and listening skills.

In this course students will have their own language portfolios that show what they have studied in each chapter, what they do well and where they need to study harder.

The textbook *Der grüne Max Neu 1* is aligned with the language proficiencies outlined in the *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages*.

On successful completion of this course students will move up to the "*Kids Explorer Level A1.2*".

- Saying what town/country they are from
- Describing their own and their friend's personality
- Introducing and talking about family members
- Talking about male and female occupations
- Talking about occupations of their family members and their place of work
- Describing pets
- Talking about how to look after pets
- The four seasons
- How Germans celebrate Christmas, Easter and St Martin's Day.
