



Course Outline–Young Explorers

This course is for young explorers with the “Hallo Anna neu 2” book set from 6-7 years of age or Grade 1 and Grade 2 who have a slight higher level of German or wider vocabulary or have completed the “Young Learners” class.

Children will learn to use more adjectives in a sentence and have a better understanding of German grammar and text. They will also extend their German vocabulary and build competency in speaking and understanding the German language in a fun and interactive way. Students will be supported by the textbook set “Hallo Anna neu 2” (2 books), worksheets, picture cards, various games, songbooks, audio CDs and You Tube videos.

Topics covered in this course include:

- Good morning, good afternoon
- My class at school
- Food likes and dislikes
- Counting
- Colors and textures
- What is in my school bag
- My grandparents and me
- Describing items, clothes
- Seasons & celebrations in German culture
- Emotions & Feelings

Learning Outcomes–On completion of this class, children will have learnt the following:

- Story telling from picture cards
- Describing special events like Easter or Christmas

- **How to ask for things, help and appropriate response**
- **Explaining likes and dislikes for food & beverages**
- **Greetings and responses**
- **Simple sentence construction**
- **How to count from 1 to 100 +**
