



Course Outline – Young Learners

This course is for young learners from 5-6 years of age or Prep & Grade 1.

Children will learn basic German sentences and grammar used in simple conversation through mime, rhymes, songs and texts. They will also extend their German vocabulary and build competency in speaking and understanding the German language in a fun and interactive way. Students will be supported by the textbook system **"Hallo Anna 1"**, worksheets, picture cards, various games, songbooks, videos and audio CDs.

Topics covered in this course include:

- Me and my family
- My activities
- My school day
- My pets
- German ABC – extended to double sounds and word recognition
- Numbers 1-100
- Exploring Food
- Asking for something & response
- Seasons & celebrations in German culture
- Emotions & Feelings

Learning Outcomes – On completion of this class, children will have learnt the following:

- Basic story telling from picture cards
- Expressing feelings and emotions

- How to ask for direction, help and appropriate response
- Explaining likes and dislikes for food & beverages
- Greetings and responses
- Simple sentence construction
- How to count from 1 to 100

Materials – To support the children’s learning experience, the following materials are used in this course: **'Hallo Anna1' course book and 'Hallo Anna1' exercise book** (needs to be purchased by parents) as well as KIKUS worksheets and KIKUS picture cards, song sheets, books, blocks, puzzles, games and audio CDs which are provided by BGLS.
