



Course Outline – Juniors Excel Level B1 Plus

This course is for high school students, who successfully completed the "Juniors Advanced B1" course or can demonstrate the German language at that level. German grammar and new vocabulary are covered at the end of each module in the *Mit uns B1+* textbooks, which is aligned with the language proficiencies outlined in the *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages*.

This is an engaging course with a communicative approach to extended grammar and vocabulary acquisition. It also provides lots of opportunities to increase student's communicative fluency as well as their German reading and writing skills. It caters for different abilities and learning styles and it encourages students to make cultural references, thereby gaining a better understanding of cultural differences.
