



## Course Outline – Juniors Explorers Level A1 Plus

This course uses the *"Magnet neu A2"* books and is for learners from 9 years of age or grade 4 in school who successfully completed the *"Kids Beginners/Explorers"* or *"Juniors Beginners"* class or can demonstrate a sound knowledge of the German language.

This is an engaging course with a communicative approach to extended grammar and vocabulary acquisition. It also provides lots of opportunities to increase student's communicative fluency as well as their German reading and writing skills. It caters for different abilities and learning styles and it encourages students to make cultural references, thereby gaining a better understanding of German history and cultural differences.

German grammar and new vocabulary are covered at the end of each chapter in the *Magnet neu A2* textbooks, which is aligned with the language proficiencies outlined in the *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages*.

- Saying how they celebrate their birthday
- Discussing holiday destinations
- Expressing their and other people's holiday plans
- Talking about what to do on holidays
- Talking about the weather
- Discussing jobs and careers
- Saying what career they have in mind
- Discussing statistics of most popular male and female occupations
- Talking about activities students have in mind after finishing school
- Exchanging memories about their first day in school
- Asking grandparents about their lives/past events
- Knowing about well known personalities/artists and their work
