



Course Outline – Juniors

Overview

Catering for students older than those in our *Kids Beginners* course, this course provides a clearly structured modern language program based on a communicative approach to grammar and vocabulary acquisition. It will serve as the foundation for effectively speaking, understanding, reading and writing German. It is a flexible course catering for different abilities and learning styles, and it encourages students to make cross-cultural references.

German grammar and new vocabulary are covered at the end of each chapter in the *Magnet A1 neu* textbook, which is aligned with the language proficiencies outlined in the *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages*.

- Saying their name, age and address
- Saying where they are from
- Expressing likes and dislikes
- Describing their own family and pets
- Introducing and describing their friends and the clique they belong to
- Talking about places, holidays
- Talking about school, subjects and their time table

- Saying what people eat for breakfast and lunch
- Talking about fast food, restaurants
- Asking for, and telling the time
- Talking about daily routines
- Talking about sport and hobbies
- Discussing interests and preferences
- Describing items of clothing and discussing fashion
- Talking about the price of clothing items and buying clothes
